

2010 HAMMOND HS AFTER PROM PERMISSION SLIP and LIABILITY WAIVER

General Information:

This After Prom Event is sponsored by the Hammond High School PTSA. The After Prom Event will be held at AMC Columbia 14 Theater on May 2, 2010 and will begin at 12:30 a.m. and end at 5:00 am. All students/guests must arrive by 1:00 am or they will not be admitted and if a student leaves the event they will not be readmitted. All students/guests must provide a permission slip and liability waiver signed by a parent or guardian in order to attend After Prom Events. This permission slip and waiver must be supplied at the time tickets are requested. All non Hammond High guests must be approved by the Hammond High School Administration. Admittance to the After Prom event requires the following: photo school ID or Valid Drivers License/Learners Permit, and a ticket to the event. Tickets to the event will not be sold at the door.

Guidelines/Rules while at After Prom event:

- No food or drinks may be brought into the event from outside.
- Students/Parents are responsible for transportation to and from the event. Please be aware of driving regulations.
- Students must be present at the event in order to win any prizes/prize packages.
- Students will be provided an area to change from prom attire if they so choose, but all clothing items and bags must be checked in the coat/bag check area after changing. Hangers and bags will be provided for dress clothes.
- Students are not allowed to carry bags (including but not limited to backpacks, other packs, or purses) during the event. All bags and coats/clothing can be checked in the designated area which will be supervised for the duration of the event. Students may request permission to access bags at any time, but will not be permitted to take bags from the coat check area once secured. All bags are subject to search at the discretion of the Hammond High School PTSA.
- All students must exhibit appropriate behavior at all times. The definition of appropriate behavior is in accordance with that outlined in Howard County Public School System Secondary Student Handbook (2008-2009), Article X (Civility) and Article XI. B. (Alcohol, other drugs, prescription medication and Over-the-counter products – Board Policy #9230). No possession or use of Alcohol, Drugs, or tobacco products will be tolerated at any time.
- Any violations involving criminal behavior will be handled in accordance with the police jurisdiction where the event occurs. Consequences for violations of appropriate behavior, as defined above, and these rules as listed, will be at the discretion of the PTSA and could include expulsion from this event and being banned from all future After Prom events; and/or a call to parents. Police and/or Security personnel will be in attendance at all times for the duration of the event.

Parents will be contacted in the event of the following:

1. violation of any rules of conduct resulting in expulsion from the event or intervention by police/security
2. students who do not arrive by 1 am
